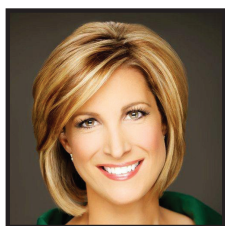

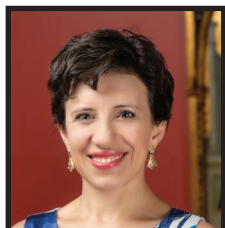

ANGELICA DANE0 “Glory of Venice” Masterworks/the Renaissance - DAM Curator of Painting & Sculpture

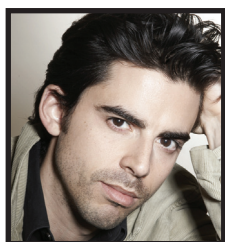

KENNETH T WALSH “America’s New President: Governing a Divided Nation”

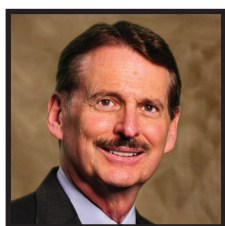
